AFFIDAVIT OF ARREST WARRANT

COUNTY OF DALLAS

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the undersigned affiant who, after being duly sworn by me, on oath stated: My name is Esteban Montenegro #6991 and I am a peace officer of the City of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas. I, the affiant, have good reason and do believe that on or about the 5th day of September, 2013, one (name of suspect) Patrick Lynn Russell Black/Male/12-25-1991 did then and there in the City of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas commit the offense of CAPITAL MURDER, a violation of Section 19.03 of the TEXAS PENAL CODE, a CAPITAL FELONY

_____, a fellow peace officer of the City of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas, who personally participated in the investigation of this alleged offense, providing information to Affiant, and whose information Affiant believes to be credible.

On September 5, 2013, at about 11:01 p.m. Dallas Police Officers responded to a shooting call at the San Mateo Forest Apartments located at 7130 San Mateo Blvd., Dallas, TX. The crime scene evidence showed that an exchange of gun fire had occurred between the deceased complainants and several suspects, three who were later identified as Dewen Vann Knight, Charles Edward Russell and Patrick Lynn Russell. Immediately after the shooting, several witnesses came forward and provided a description of the suspect vehicle. One witness also reported a black male shot during the exchange of gun fire. The black male who was shot was seen leaving in the red vehicle from the offense location with three other black male suspects. Several minutes later, Garland Police Department reported two black males one with a gunshot wound to the abdomen at the Shell/7-11 gas station located at 11405 LBJ Freeway. Witness at the Shell/7-11 gas station stated to Garland Police officers that a red vehicle fitting the suspect vehicle description dropped off two black males that fit the description of the suspects seen at the offense location. Suspect Charles Russell was transported to Baylor Hospital with a gunshot wound to the abdomen and Garland Police officers detained Suspect Knight for detectives. Both complainants, Tavares Tell and Kenny Garcia died from the gunshot wounds.

The crime scene was processed and physical evidence was collected. Among the items collected were fingerprints and blood samples from the complainant's 2013 4 door black Ford Focus New Mexico License plate 256-RYD.


Suspect Knight was transported to Police Headquarters. Suspect Knight was read his Miranda Warning. Suspect Knight understood his right and waived his rights and agreed to talk to Detective Montenegro. During the interview Suspect Knight admitted to being at the offense location during the shooting. He also admitted that the motive was to rob the complainants of their drugs at gun point, an armed robbery. Suspect Knight distanced himself from being an active participant in the offense and minimized his role and stated he only stayed in the car. Suspect Knight incriminated Charles Russell as one of the shooters and provided a detailed description of the role Suspect Charles Russell played in the murder which corroborates the physical evidence found at the crime scene. Furthermore, Suspect Knight stated that he knows the second shooter as "Patrick". "Patrick" was later identified as Patrick Lynn Russell. Suspect Knight also provided detectives with a detailed description of the role Patrick Lynn Russell played in the murder. All of Suspect Knight's descriptions of how the events of the shooting took place are corroborated by the physical evidence and independent witnesses accounts.

On September 16, 2013, Detective Blank #5114 conducted a fingerprint comparison from several fingerprint cards of four individuals and were compared to the fingerprints lifted from the complainant's 2013 4 door black Ford Focus. Detective Blank individualized the right and left palms of Patrick L. Russell, Black male 12-25-1991 with the latents prints found on the "outside passenger door", "outside rear passenger side door" and found "outside passenger side panel" of the complainant's black Ford vehicle.




