

White Rock Lake 2021-2022 Winter Tree Trimming Update

The information in this document is to inform all necessary people about what will be happening during this tree trimming season. Based on the outcome of the tree assessment with the City Forester, City-Wide Manager, City Urban Biologist, District Arborist, City Forestry Manager, District Manager and the Lake Supervisor we have come up with the following update and plan below. As you know we are going into the winter season and it has been topic of conversation to continue with the push to move forward decisively in a coordinated effort between forestry and the district teams. Below is a general statement that applies to all removals listed in this document.

(District arborists [Lloyd Green, Mike Maxon] have conducted tree assessments, then passed on to City Biologist [Brett Johnson] for his review and approval, then passed on to City Forester [Chris McMasters] for his review and approval and then passed to the Forestry department for scheduling)

Locations:

Section 11 (East Lawther & Winfrey Point)-

1. Removals:
 - a. Pecan @ trail - located at 911 marker (101)
 - b. Pecan @ trail - located close to south parking lot at Winfrey Point
 - c. Ash @ trail - located on southside of Winfrey Point
 - d. Redbuds @ trail - located along westside of Winfrey Point
2. General Trim to include dead, broken and other
3. Specific trees for pruning:
 - a. American Elm @ trail - located on northside of Winfrey Point
 - b. American Elm @ trail - located on westside of Winfrey Point
 - c. American Elm @ parking lot - located on southside of Winfrey Point south of parking lot
 - d. Pecan @ parking lot - located on southside of Winfrey Point south of parking lot
 - e. Pecan @ trail - located at 911 marker 105

Section 10 (Sunset Bay & Celebration Tree Grove)-

1. Removals:
 - a. Pecan @ Sunset Bay - located along creek)
 - b. Cottonwood @ Sunset Bay - located close to road
 - c. Pecan @ Sunset Bay - located close to road
 - d. Red Oak @ Poppy Lane area - located along trail
 - e. Bois D'arc @ Poppy Lane area - located close to picnic table
 - f. Pecan @ Poppy Lane area - located close to picnic table
 - g. Pecan @ Poppy Lane area - located close to closed latrine

- h. Bois D'arc @ Poppy Lane area - located close to 911 marker (174)
 - i. Cedar Elm @ Poppy Lane area - located close trail & Appts.
 - j. Bois D'arc @ Poppy Lane area - located close to closed latrine
 - k. Chinquapin oak @ Poppy Lane area - located close to road
 - l. Pecan @ Poppy Lane area - located close to road
 - m. 2 Redbuds @ Celebration area - located close to seating area

 3. Specific trees for pruning:
 - a. Bois D'arc @ Poppy Lane area - clean up dead
 - b. Cedar Elm @ Poppy Lane area - corrective cut
 - c. Youpon @ Celebration area - trim off DG path

Section 9 (Stone Tables)-

1. Removals:
 - a. Ash @ Buckner marquee area
 - b. Sycamore @ Buckner marquee area
 - c. Ash @ Buckner marquee area
 - d. Willow @ Stone Tables area
 - e. Pecan @ Stone Tables area (leaning)
 - f. Cedar Elms (6) past Stone Tables (Location for tree planting spring 2022)
 - g. Cottonwood past Stone Tables
2. General Trim to include dead, broken and other
3. Specific trees for pruning:
 - a. Ash @ Buckner marquee area - clean up dead
 - b. Live Oak @ Buckner marquee area - storm damage clean up
 - c. Cottonwood @ Buckner marquee area by power lines - remove dead liter
 - d. Ash @ Buckner marquee area by cottonwood - clean up dead
 - e. Sycamore @ Buckner marquee area - remove dead limbs
 - f. Cottonwood @ Buckner marquee area by marquee - remove deadwood
 - g. Pile of debris by creek to be removed
 - h. Remove fallen dead tree
 - i. Mulberry @ Stone Tables area - remove deadwood
 - j. American Elm @ Stone Tables area - remove deadwood and lift canopy
 - k. Willows (3) - remove deadwood
 - l. Large trunk in wetland to be removed
 - m. Oncor line trimming near Stone Tables area
 - n. Remove stump @ Stone Tables past latrine
 - o. Pecan @ Stone Tables area (past) - remove hanger
4. Tree Grove planting limb up training to be given to district staff - (City Forester [Chris McMaster] is conducting an onsite tree pruning training with the district strike teams at the new established tree groves north of the "Stone Tables")

Section 8 (Dreyfuss & Bath House)-

1. Removals:
 - a. Red Oak @ Dreyfuss area - located along street
 - b. Sweet Gum @ Dreyfuss area - located @ circle
 - c. Dead tree @ Dreyfuss area - located by 4 wooden picnic tables
 - d. Red Cedar @ Dreyfuss area - located by upper parking lot
 - e. Bradford Pear @ Dreyfuss area - located on island hill
 - f. American Elm @ Dreyfuss area - located by lower parking lot
 - g. Pecans (2) @ Dreyfuss area - located by lower parking lot
 - h. Palm @ Bath House area - located at front door of bldg.,
 - i. American Elm @ Bath House area - located at west parking lot
 - j. Cedar Elm @ Bath House area - located at east parking lot
2. General Trim to include dead, broken and other
3. Specific trees for pruning:
 - a. Bios D'arc @ Dreyfuss area - trim for habitat
 - b. Remove stump @ Dreyfuss area
 - c. Remove Red Oak stump @ Dreyfuss area - by culvert
 - d. Ash (3) @ Dreyfuss area - remove deadwood and clean up
 - e. Oncor light pole needs clearance trim @ Bath House area - west parking area
 - f. Remove stump @ Bath House area - covered in vines
